DERRY CITY COUNCIL

Made by Derry City Council under Article 18 (2) of the Airports (NI) Order 1994(a) (hereinafter called "the Order") applying to City of Derry Airport.

1. INTERPRETATION

In these byelaws :-

'airport manager' includes any other person for the time being in charge of the airport;

'airport official' means a person authorised by the undertaking to act as an official for the purpose of the byelaws;

'constable' means a person appointed by the undertaking to be a constable on the airport under Article 19 of the Order;

'undertaking' means Derry City Council or its statutory successor;

'vehicle' does not include aircraft.

2. CITATION AND COMMENCEMENT

These byelaws may be cited as the Derry City Council, City of Derry Airport Byelaws 1996 and shall come into operation on the thirty-first day after they are confirmed by the Department of the Environment.

3. PENALTIES

Any person contravening any of these byelaws shall be guilty of an offence and be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 2 on the standard scale for each offence and in the case of a continuing offence to a further fine not exceeding £5.00 per day after written notice of the offence from the airport undertaking.

4. BYELAWS

Within the airport;-

- (1) A person shall not tamper or interfere or attempt to tamper or interfere with any aircraft or anything used in connection with any aircraft.
- (2) A person shall not enter or climb upon or attempt to enter or climb upon any part of any aircraft without authority of the person in charge of it.

- (3) A person shall not enter or get on or attempt to enter or get on any vehicle, truck, trolley or aircraft steps or tamper with the brake or other part of its mechanism without lawful authority or reasonable cause.
- (4) A person shall not place an aircraft other than in the place and position designated by the airport manager.
- (5) A person in charge of any stationary aircraft not in a hangar shall ensure that it is properly moored or otherwise secured.
- (6) A person shall not operate or cause to put into operation an aircraft engine in a hangar.
- (7) A person shall not without the permission of the airport manager, clean, service or maintain aircraft, vehicles or equipment or run aircraft engines in areas other than those designated by the airport manager.
- (8) A person shall not without the permission of the airport manager, take a vehicle into a hangar used for the maintenance or storage of aircraft.
- (9) A person shall not wilfully and without good cause operate, or attempt to operate, any switch or lever of any escalator, lift or other machinery upon or near which is displaced a notice that it is intended only to be operated in case of emergency.
- (10) A person shall not tamper with, interfere with, or misuse, or attempt to tamper with, interfere with, or misuse, any escalator, travolator, conveyor belt, power-operated gangway, or any mechanical, electrical or electronic apparatus without lawful authority or reasonable cause, and a person shall not operate or use, in such a way as to prejudice the operation of any communication or navigation systems at the airport, any radio transmitter or other thing capable of radiating or generating electrical interference.

- (11) A person shall not smoke in or otherwise bring or light any naked light into or in
- (a) any place where any such act is prohibited by notice erected and displaced by the undertaking; or
 - (b) any place within fifty feet of any aircraft or a store or quantity of liquid fuel or explosives after having been requested to desist by any constable or aircraft official, except that a person may smoke in suitably fire proofed hangar offices and in the waiting rooms of the buildings through which passengers pass between air and ground transport.
- (12) A person shall not commit any act causing or likely to cause an outbreak of fire.
- (13) A person shall not without the permission of the airport manager light a fire.
- (14) A person shall not wilfully give a false fire, ambulance, bomb warning or other emergency alarm by any means.
- (15) A person shall not without the permission of the airport manager, fill or discharge from any container, including any part of a vehicle, liquid fuel elsewhere than in a place approved for that purpose by the airport manager.
- (16) A person shall not without the permission of the airport manager, drive or place a vehicle on the airport elsewhere than in the places from time to time provided for the passage or accommodation of such vehicle.
- (17) A person shall not:-
- (a) drive a motor vehicle recklessly, or at a speed or in a manner which is dangerous to other persons, having regard to all the circumstances of the case, including the nature, condition and use of those parts of the airport, and the amount of traffic which is actually at the time, or which might reasonably be expected to be, on such parts; or
 - (b) drive a motor vehicle without due care and attention or without reasonable consideration for other persons using those parts of the airport.

- (18) A person in charge of a vehicle shall comply with an indication or direction given by either:-
 - (a) a traffic sign erected and displayed by the undertaking placed on or near such parts of the airport; or
 - (b) a constable or an airport official for the time being engaged in the regulation of traffic.
- (19) A person shall not wait, leave or park a vehicle in excess of the permitted time in an area where the period of waiting is restricted by a notice erected and displayed by the undertaking.
- (20) In any case where an accident occurs, the driver of any vehicle involved in the accident shall stop, and shall report the accident to a constable, as soon as reasonably practicable and in any event before leaving the airport.
- (21) A person shall comply with all notices erected and displayed by the undertaking prohibiting or restricting access of any person, animal, vehicle or thing to any building, road or part of the airport.
- (22) A person shall not loiter, frequent or remain without reasonable cause on any part of the airport.
- (23) A person shall not allow any vehicle, animal or thing to remain after having been required to remove it, or after its presence had been forbidden by a constable or an airport official.
- (24) A person shall not throw, leave or drop anything capable of causing injury to any person or property.
- (25) A person shall not climb any wall, fence, barrier, railing or post.
- (26) A person shall not obstruct or interfere with the proper use of the airport.
- (27) A person shall not obstruct any person acting in the execution of his duty in relation to the operation of the airport including (but without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing) the conveyance of passengers, their baggage and other goods and the maintenance and servicing of aircraft.
- (28) A person shall not to the annoyance of any other person sing, dance, shout, play musical instrument or erect or use any apparatus for transmission, receipt, recording, reproduction or amplification of sound, speech or images without the permission of the airport manager.
- (29) A person shall not tamper or interfere with or attempt to tamper or interfere with or wilfully misuse any telephone or other apparatus provided for transmitting and receiving messages.

- (30) A person shall not behave in a disorderly, indecent or offensive manner.
- (31) A person shall not be in a state of intoxication.
- (32) A person shall not use any indecent or offensive language which is likely to cause offence or annoyance to any person.
- (33) A person shall not organise or take part in any public assembly, demonstration or procession likely to obstruct or interfere with the proper use of the airport or cause serious public disorder or obstruct or interfere with the comfort and convenience or safety of passengers or persons using the airport.
- (34) A person shall not display any flags, banners or emblems likely to cause a breach of the peace on any part of the airport.
- (35) A person shall not write, draw or affix any obscene, abusive or offensive word, representation or character, upon or wilfully soil or defile any walls, structure, floor or pavement or any surface forming part of or used in relation to the airport.
- (36) A person shall not walk on or damage any flower bed, or without the permission of the airport manager remove, pick, or otherwise damage any tree, shrub or plant.
- (37) A person shall not without the permission of the airport manager dig up soil or cut or remove turf.
- (38) A person shall not without the permission of the airport manager drop or otherwise deposit anything in such circumstances as to cause, contribute to, or tend to lead to, the defacement by litter of any part of the airport.
- (39) A person shall keep all animals belonging to him under proper control and in particular any dog shall be kept on a lead and not be permitted to foul the footpaths or buildings.
- (40) A person shall not without the permission of the airport manager graze any horses, cows, bulls, sheep, swine, asses, goats, poultry or any other animals on the airport or any part thereof.
- (41) A person shall not damage, deface or, without the permission of the airport manager, remove, displace or alter any building, structure or other property whether moveable or immovable (including any notice) forming part of or provided for or in connection with the airport or erect or place on any part of the airport any structure or property.
- (42) A person shall not without the permission of the airport manager enter or leave the airport otherwise than through a gate or entrance for the time being provided for that purpose.
- (43) A person shall not without the permission of the airport manager, enter any part of the airport to which members of the public are not for the time being admitted.

- (44) A person shall not use a photo, cine or video apparatus of any kind without the permission of the airport manager.
- (45) A person shall not without the permission of the airport manager sell or distribute anything, offer anything for sale or hire or make any offer of services.
- (46) A person shall not cause a vehicle plying for hire to wait otherwise than at standings designated by the airport manager.
- (47) A person shall not wash down or clean out a motor vehicle of any description on the airport except in areas designated for such purpose by the undertaking.
- (48) A person shall not without the permission of the airport manager post, distribute or display signs, advertisement, circulars or other printed or written matter.
- (49) A person shall not without the permission of the airport manager beg or solicit funds or contributions of any kind.
- (50) A person shall not enter the airport except as a bona fide airline passenger, or where he has been permitted to enter by a constable or an airport official.
- (51) A person shall not remain on the airport or any part thereof, after having been requested by a constable or an airport official to leave.
- (52) Without prejudice to byelaws (50 and 51), a person, whether a bona fide airline passenger or not, who refuses to be searched or to have his baggage or any vehicle in his charge searched by a constable or an airport official shall not remain on the airport or any part thereof after having been requested by such constable or airport official to leave and shall not re-enter the airport except as a bona fide airline passenger willing to submit to such searches as aforesaid.
- (53) A person shall not enter or remain upon or use the airport for the purpose of bookmaking or betting or wagering or agreeing to bet or wager or paying or receiving or settling bets with any other persons.
- (54) A person shall upon being requested to do so by a constable or an airport official state his name and address and the purpose of his being on the airport.

5. GRANT OF PERMISSION

Where anything is permitted under these byelaws only upon the permission of the undertaking or the airport manager being first obtained any permission so granted may be revoked at any time by the undertaking or the airport manager without any obligation to state the reasons therefore.

6. REVOCATION

From and after the date on which this Byelaw shall come into operation, the Eglinton Airport Byelaws 1988 made by the Council on the 1st day of March 1988 and confirmed by the Department of the Environment on the 3rd day of March 1988 shall be and are hereby revoked.
